AWOP - Absence without pay - Page 12

Absences without pay (<u>AWOP</u>) must be submitted to the Superintendent or designee for prior approval unless the absence is associated with an already approved Family and Medical Leave of Absence (<u>FMLA</u>). This step is required for employees who are not substitutes or working on a part-time basis. Failure to do so could result in an unapproved absence and lead to disciplinary action. Absences requiring Superintendent approval will require the completion of an online absence request form submitted through our online forms system Script. Please use the following links for absence request submittals – <u>CERTIFIED</u> <u>STAFF ABSENCE REQUEST</u> and <u>NON-CERTIFIED ABSENCE REQUEST</u>

What is the history of Paraprofessional Appreciation Day?

In the 1960s, paraprofessionals were hired to work in schools thanks to an anti-poverty program implemented by President Lyndon B. Johnson. It wasn't until the 1970s that the impact of paraprofessionals began to take shape. Through the 1970s, the role of paraprofessional transformed. It is believed that the idea of honoring paraprofessionals came a little later when the governor of Missouri decided to celebrate the work of paraprofessionals in the education sector. Since then, Paraprofessional Appreciation Day has spread across the country, with many districts taking the first Wednesday in April as a chance to say "thanks."


DEADLINE TO RESPOND May 1st




Some staff receive a letter annually that provides notice of assurance of continued employment for the following school year. In previous years, these letters which were printed on green paper were mailed home.
